

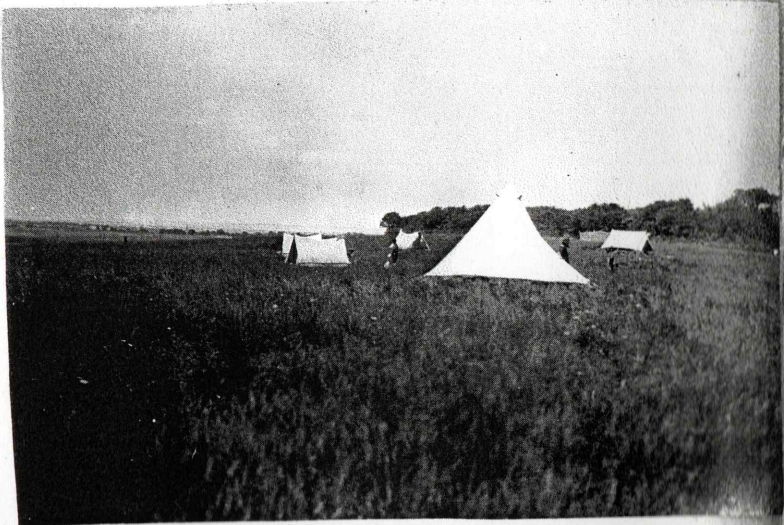

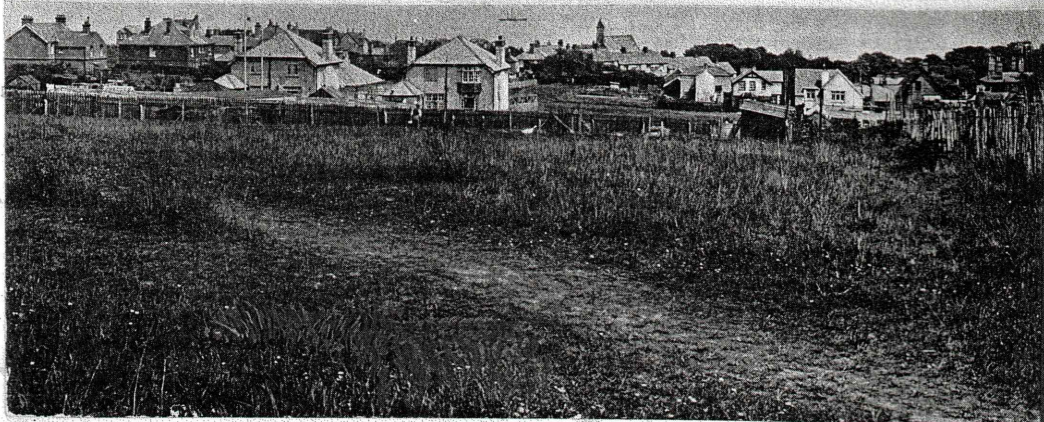

BIRDS EYE VIEW. KINGSDOWN.



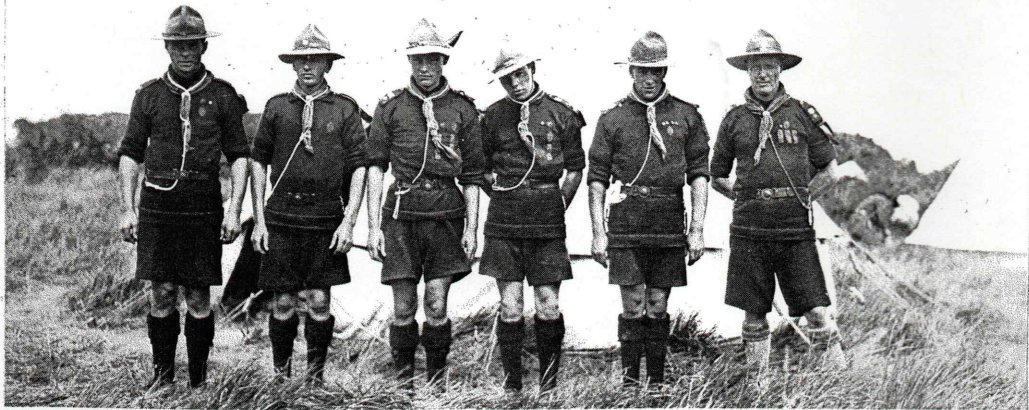

Cricket match in the afternoon, & a big Camp fire with a visitors troop, Rows & 3 guides as visitors!

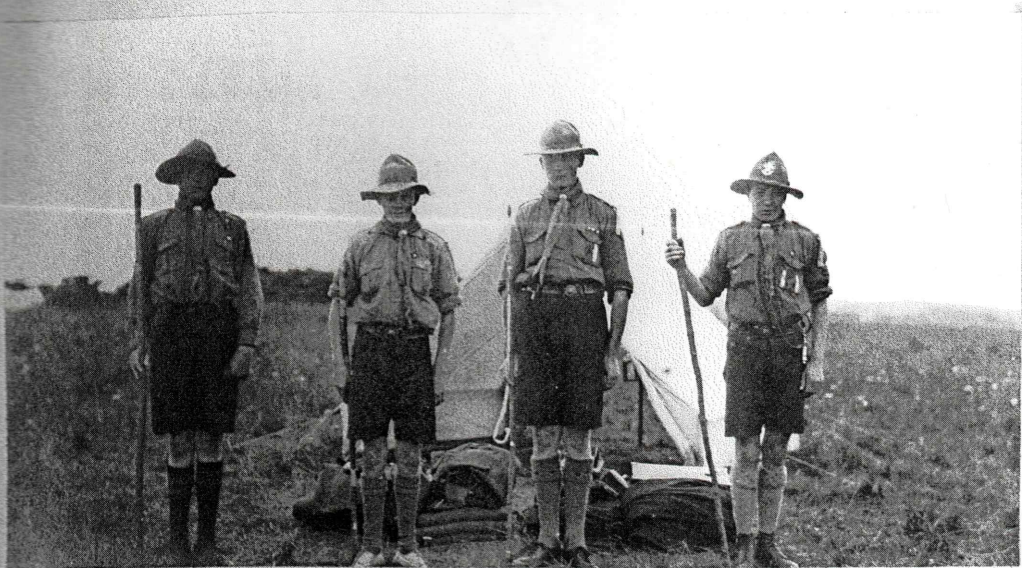
Monday 9th Aug.

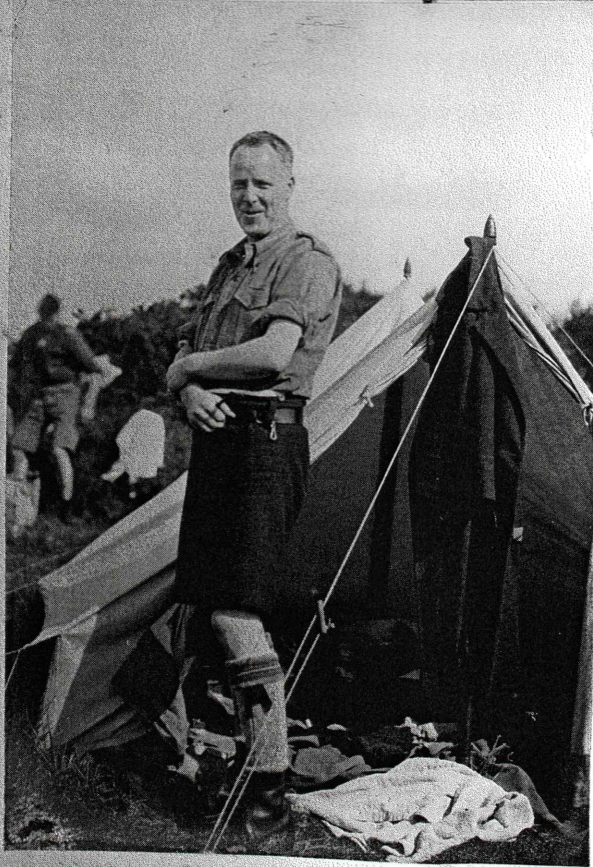
